

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES, CREATING A NEW SECTION TO CHAPTER 2.29 OF THE EATONVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Council desires to amend its code addressing the positions of police chief and deputy police chief to enable the Town to procure law enforcement services from other government agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Council is the legislative authority of the Town of Eatonville,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Eatonville as follows:

Section 1. A new section is added to chapter 2.29 of the Eatonville Municipal Code, to be codified as EMC 2.29.030, to read as follows:

**2.29.030 Department After Execution of Interlocal Agreement.**

Upon execution of an interlocal agreement with another municipal corporation or political subdivision of the State of Washington under chapter 39.34 RCW, the Mayor may eliminate the positions of the chief of police and deputy chief of police and appoint a government official from said municipal corporation or political subdivision to serve as the Town's marshal under RCW 35.27.070 and RCW 35.27.240, PROVIDED that the execution of such agreement is specifically authorized by resolution of the Council. In such a case, the positions described in EMC 2.29.010 and EMC 2.29.020 shall cease to exist until such time as the termination of said interlocal agreement for law enforcement services to be provided to the Town.

Section 2. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this ordinance of the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such order or judgment shall be confined in its operation to the controversy in which it was rendered and shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any parts thereof to any person or circumstances and to this end the provisions of each clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this law are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after publication of a summary, consisting of the title.
