Discussion on potential projects

Committee member **Pierce** stated that he had requested to have a TBD meeting and feels that there are a lot of street repairs that need to be done. The two priorities identified by **Pierce** were the intersection of Hilligoss Lane and Eatonville Highway and also the intersection of Ohop Valley Ext Road and Meridian. He feels that these need to be professionally repaired and would like signage to identify any projects that are paid for using Transportation Benefit District funds.

Committee member **Gribi** agrees and would like citizen comment and input by way of Facebook.

Committee member **Walter** would like to see more marking on the sidewalk slopes along Washington Ave.

Committee member **Pierce** mentioned that the painting could be done during the 911 Day of Service project and encouraged everyone to look for other projects that could be done that day.

Committee member **Gribi** stated that we need to hold a TBD meeting at least one time per year.

Committee member **Pierce** agreed and felt that there should be a TBD meeting two times per year.

Committee member **Schrimpsker** agrees with two TBD meetings per year.

Committee member **Gribi** made a motion to hold a Transportation Benefit District meeting at least semi-annually and was seconded by Council member **Pierce**. All were in favor.
