

RESOLUTION 2012-GGG

A RESOLUTION OF THE EATONVILLE TOWN COUNCIL SUSPENDING ANNUAL CONSUMER PRICE INDEX ADJUSTMENTS TO WATER, WASTEWATER, STORMWATER, AND REFUSE RATES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR TO PROVIDE RELIEF TO RATEPAYERS

WHEREAS, Resolution 2011-B currently provides a process for adjusting utility rates annually based on the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) Greater Metropolitan Index;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution 2011-B, utility rates for water, wastewater, stormwater, and refuse are scheduled to increase by 1.9 percent effective January 1, 2013, and;

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to suspend this 1.9 percent automatic adjustment for 2013 for the water, wastewater (sewer), stormwater and refuse from taking effect for a period of one year and bank it so that the 1.9% adjustment takes effect on January 1, 2014 in addition to the 2013 automatic adjustment which will be calculated in April of 2013, and;

WHEREAS, the council has found that the water, wastewater, stormwater, and refuse utilities can make cutbacks to offset this lost revenue, **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Eatonville as follows:

Section 1: The 1.9 percent annual consumer price index rate adjustment for water, wastewater, stormwater, and refuse rates as authorized by resolution 2011-B and scheduled to take effect January 1, 2013 is hereby suspended until January 1, 2014. This 1.9 percent rate adjustment as calculated using April 2012 consumer price index data shall take effect on January 1, 2014 and shall be added to the rate adjustment to be calculated using consumer price index data to be gathered in April, 2013 and scheduled to take effect on January 1, 2014 in accordance with section 6 of resolution 2011-B.
