

RESOLUTION 2012-HHH

A RESOLUTION OF THE EATONVILLE TOWN COUNCIL CUTTING WATER, WASTEWATER, REFUSE, AND ELECTRIC RATES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR TO PROVIDE RELIEF TO RATEPAYERS

WHEREAS, town water, wastewater, and refuse rates have been adjusted upward annually every year since their creation to account for inflation; and,

WHEREAS, the council has found that the water, wastewater, and refuse utilities are in a strong enough position to reduce their expenditures to facilitate a temporary rate cut for a period of one year, and;

WHEREAS, the electric rates established in 2004 have produced a consistently healthy electrical budget and cash reserves, and;

WHEREAS, the council has found that the electric utility is in a strong enough position to reduce its expenditures to facilitate a temporary rate cut for a period of one year, and;

WHEREAS, the council wishes to offer its rate payers relief for a period of one year; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Eatonville as follows:

Section 1: Effective on January 1, 2013 the adopted 2012 rates for water, wastewater, refuse, and electric are hereby reduced for the Period of January 1, 2013 until January 1, 2014 as follows:

Water: 12%

Wastewater: 6%

Refuse: 12%

Electric: 8%

Section 2: This resolution shall expire and cease all effect on January 1, 2014. Absent future Council action to the contrary, the 2012 rates would be reinstated and adjusted for inflation in accordance with Resolution 2011-B and Resolution 2012-GGG as if this resolution had never passed.
