
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, AMENDING CHAPTER
16.54.070 STORM WATER MANAGEMENT AND EROSION CONTROL
SECTION D.

Section 1. Eatonville Municipal Code Section 16.54.070 and Ordinance No. 98-16 – 98-7 are each hereby amended as follows:

D. Any person who fails to obtain the proper site development and/or erosion control and storm water management permit prior to doing any grading, filling, clearing, excavating, or ditching; or creating an impervious surface; or doing any development or redevelopment activity unless pursuant to the provisions of this chapter and/or fails to comply with a written request of the director or his designee shall be liable to the town for a civil infraction as well as all civil remedies available at law. Each violation, and in the case of continuing violation, each day of continued violation shall be a separate and distinct violation. Civil penalties will be assessed at a rate of \$250.00, per day per violation, and statutory assessments will be in addition to this amount. (Ord. 98-16 § 7, 1998).

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
