

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF \$221,607 FROM THE RAILS-TO-TRAILS CONSERVANCY IN PARTNERSHIP WITH CHRISTINE AND PETER KOCH AND THE ESTATE OF HOWARD S. "BUD" BLANCHER AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT LIMITING THE USE OF SUCH FUNDS TO THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE RIMROCK TRAIL INCLUDING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE OVER THE LITTLE MASHEL RIVER

WHEREAS, The Rails-to-Trails Conservancy has received donations from Christine and Peter Koch and the estate of Howard S. "Bud" Blancher; and

WHEREAS, The Rails-to-Trails Conservancy wishes to transfer these funds to the Town of Eatonville for use in the planning and construction of the Rimrock Trail including a pedestrian bridge at the Little Mashel River; and

WHEREAS, the attached donation agreement sets forth the conditions which are attached to the gift;

NOW, THEREFORE,

The Town Council of the Town of Eatonville, Washington, do ordain as follows:


Section 1. The Council of the Town of Eatonville hereby accepts a donation/gift of Two Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Six Hundred Seven Dollars (\$221,607.00) from the Rails-to-Trails Conservancy, subject to the attached Donation Agreement.

Section 2. The Council authorizes the Mayor to sign the attached agreement with the Rails-to-Trails Conservancy.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication of a summary, consisting of the title.


