

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON, REPEALING CHAPTER 2.24 OF THE EATONVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Council desires to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Bonney Lake to obtain municipal court services;

WHEREAS, by contracting with Bonney Lake, it is appropriate to terminate the Eatonville Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the Council is the legislative authority of the Town of Eatonville,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Eatonville as follows:

Section 1. The Eatonville Municipal Court is hereby terminated pursuant to RCW 3.50.805. The following sections and articles of the respective ordinances are hereby repealed: Ordinance 190 (1962), §§ 1-2, Ordinance 84-11 (1984), § 1; Ordinance 93-04 (1993), § 8, each of which are codified respectively at EMC 2.24.010, EMC 2.24.020, and EMC 2.24.030:


Section 2. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or part of this ordinance of the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such order or judgment shall be confined in its operation to the controversy in which it was rendered and shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any parts thereof to any person or circumstances and to this end the provisions of each clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this law are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect at 11:59 p.m. on ~~September 30~~, 2012.




