**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Review of the Sign Ordinance 2007-19**

**Mayor Schaub** explained that it has been five years since the passing of the current sign ordinance and felt that it would be a good time for a practical review of how it's working. There have been some questions about the flag signs (feather signs) and how they fit into the code, the flag signs are rather new and were not part of the landscape then. He would like to hear from the business owners. He suggested that the planning commissioners review how the town should address this. Another concern which came from Councilperson Gribi was the appeal process. How someone would go about making an appeal?

**Commissioner Beach** suggested that the town advertise a public hearing on the sign code. Anyone with concerns about the sign ordinance should come to the meeting. The sign ordinance is a rather complex thing and it has been awhile. He was on the sign committee then and said that they spent a lot of time on it and he has a vested interest in it. He asked that town staff organize and contact people who have concerns about the signs and suggesting the second meeting of March for the public hearing. He suggested that the town advertise in the Dispatch, Facebook, website, reader board and send a letter to every business that has a sign permit. Commissioner Beach feels that this is not just an issue for the businesses.
