July 2018 Water Sewer Work List Synopsis

- Daily water and wastewater water quality laboratory testing and system checks.
- Daily Water and wastewater treatment quality assurance / quality control laboratory testing
- Daily clean river intake screens 2 to 3 times per day.
- Daily mow grass in parks.
- Daily pick up garbage in parks
- Daily water flower baskets
- Daily water and wastewater treatment plant maintenance
- Locates as requested around town
- Fill pot holes as needed
- Repair water leak Center St E
- Work on river intake dam as needed.
- Mow and brush trail and right of ways around town
- Clean sewer lift stations
- Various afterhours WTP and WWTP alarms
- Repair play area at Glacier park
- Flush and rebuild chlorine chemical injectors on both filters at WTP
- Set up and tear down for 4th of July activities
- Pick up new flatbed truck and begin transformation to plow truck.
- Install new electric security gate at WTP
- Pick up trash dumped on streets
- Work with several different contractors about water sewer connections
- Help with clogged sewer on Center St E
