They were impressed by Officer Anderson's professionalism and compassion. I want to commend Officer Anderson for displaying two of our Department's Core Values.

- Daily water and wastewater treatment plant maintenance
- Daily meter reads move in/out.
- Locates as requested around town
- Fill pot holes around town.
- Repair 4 water leaks around town
- Train employees at both water and wastewater plants
- Clean sewer lift stations
- Various afterhours WTP and WWTP alarms
- Replace several wood post and faded stop signs around town
- Inspect new Water / Sewer connections.
- Several meetings with contactors about new projects that are starting.
- Clean treatment plants top to bottom.
