EMPLOYMENT ANNOUNCEMENT: POLICE OFFICER
LATERAL / ENTRY LEVEL

The Town of Eatonville Police Department is currently recruiting for a full-time entry-level or lateral police officer. Information and requirements are posted on the National Testing Network website. The department will recruit and hire only those individuals who demonstrate a commitment to service and who possess the traits and characteristics that reflect personal integrity and high ethical standards.

NATIONAL TESTING NETWORK – www.nationaltestingnetwork.com To complete an application and Personal History Questionnaire and schedule testing, log into the NTN website and follow guidelines below:

- Once logged into the NTN website, choose “Law Enforcement” under “Find Jobs”
- Select the “Eatonville Police Department” posting under the Washington heading
- Select your testing location and date from the available schedules
- Fill out and submit the NTN online application
- Fill out and submit the PHQ prior to your scheduled test date

The Personal History Questionnaire (PHQ) must be completed by both Entry and Lateral Applicants through the National Testing Network (NTN) by April 1, 2019 to be considered for hire. Applicants must also complete the Town of Eatonville Application posted on this website.

Lateral applicants must have a minimum of one-year satisfactory performance as a full-time fully commissioned law enforcement officer and successfully completed their field training officer program in a civilian law enforcement agency within the past 24 months prior to applying for this position. Also, successful completion of the Washington State CJTC Academy or can obtain successful certification through the Washington State Equivalency Academy prior to the completion of the twelve-month probationary period.

Eligibility/placement on the hiring list for all applicants will be based on the following:

Successful completion of the Physical Abilities Test (PAT)

Passing all 3 components of the written exam (video, writing and reading) with a 70% or higher score.
