I am at about my four-month mark as the Chief of Eatonville Police and I am very happy with our progress thus far. I am continually impressed with my Officer's integrity and professionalism. Public Safety Committee

There was no safety committee meeting for the month of July. The grant for ballistic helmets is under review for approval. The importance of this protection for our officers has been reinforced by the recent active shooter events occurring across the country.

Management Activities

The oral boards for the selection of a new Officer has been completed. One candidate stood out amongst them and I was happy to offer them a conditional offer of employment pending a polygraph exam, psychological evaluation and a medical screening. Once those processes are successfully completed Mayor Schaub will conduct a final interview and approval. I anticipate completing the hiring process by the end of August.

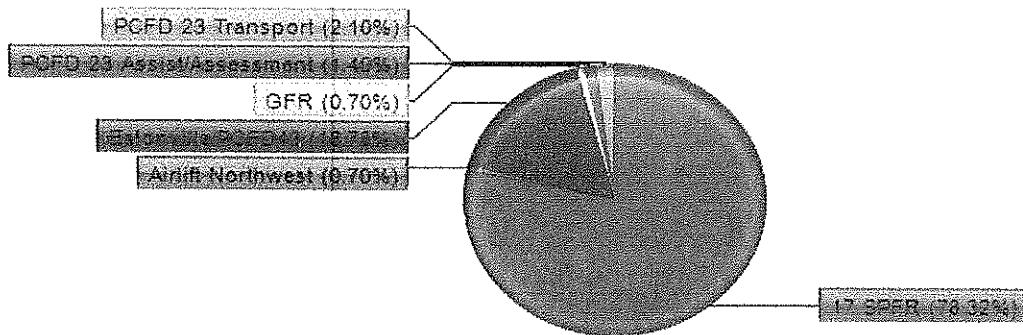

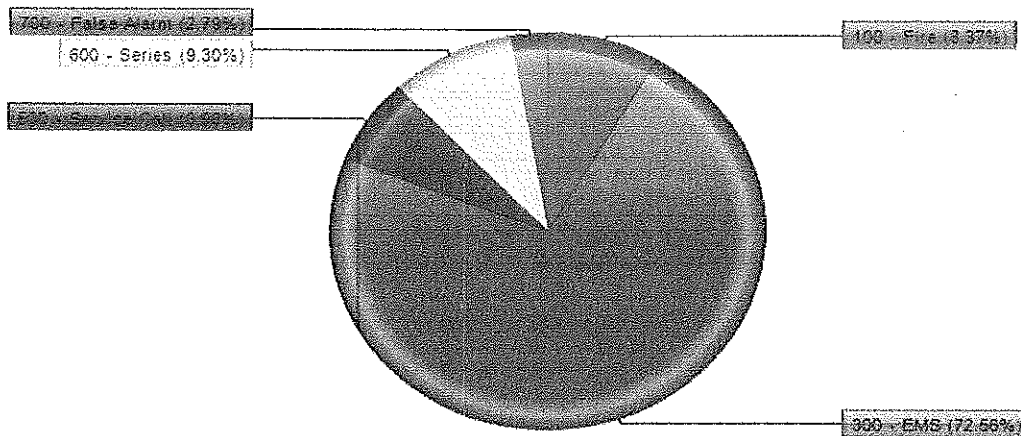
