MINUTES OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING**

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Schaub called the meeting of the Eatonville Town Council to order at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL

Town Clerk Kathy Linnemeyer called the roll. The following were:

OPENING CEREMONIES

Mayor Schaub led the assembly in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA/SET TIME RESTRICTIONS

Councilmember Thomas moved approval as amended with a two minute time restriction and was seconded by Councilmember Walter. All were in favor.

DEPARTMENT HEAD/COUNCIL COMMITTEE/BOARD/COMMISSION REPORT

- a. **Police Report-** Chief Laliberte reported that National Night Out was a success with 250-300 citizens in attendance, gave an update on the hiring process of a new officer and gave an update on the Friday morning Town Hall closure.

- b. **Fire Report** – Chief Galey stated that they can now prepare monthly reports that define the Town of Eatonville calls and announced he has resigned his position with South Pierce Fire & Rescue and that his last day will be September 30th.
- c. **Public Works Report-** Town Administrator Gribi gave updates on trail mowing, GIS, RFQ for the water project and pump track design status. She also reminded Council to complete the Parliamentary Training that everyone signed up for.
- d. **Mayor Report-** Mayor Schaub thanked Chief Galey for National Night Out and stated that it was a well rounded event. He thanked Shaken, Mt. Mist and all of the vendors for attending and announced that the Planning Commission is continuing review of the Design Standards.
