NOVEMBER 2020 REPORT

General

As the year 2020 creeps closer to an end, I am optimistic while looking forward to the decline of the COVID-19 epidemic and its encompassing dangers. I am starting my wish list for 2021 and have many projects that I would like to see come to fruition with the absence of social distancing and restrictive operations.

Public Safety Committee

The committee reviewed a proposal to enact an ordinance to allow electric golf carts within the town.

Management Activities

I will be pursuing training and purchasing munitions to allow Officers McGuire, Anderson and Duran to qualify/re-qualify with less-lethal shotguns. The less lethal shotguns are already in our inventory and will not need to be purchased. Officer McGuire was previously certified as a less lethal shotgun instructor, but his certification has expired.

This training and certification will provide a valuable alternate to potentially deadly force with subjects who are a threat to themselves, the public, or our officers.

***Officer Wade does not qualify as he carries a lethal shotgun and the two systems cannot be carried simultaneously. ***

SOUTH PIERCE FIRE AND RESCUE

- SPFR has started the recruitment process for additional Volunteer Firefighters. This includes an orientation, written exam., and oral board, physical agility, and medical examinations. We are hoping for 5-10 people in the February 2021 academy
- We would like to congratulate FF's Emily Silver-Colton and Francisco Quiroz who graduated from the Pierce County Volunteer Fire Academy. We are also expecting FF Brenden Zurfluh to graduate from the Buckley Volunteer Fire Academy in late January
- The Resident Firefighters are back in quarters at Station 175 after the well issues were taken care of
- SPFR will be accepting delivery of a new Medic Unit on December 22, 2020. It will be identical to M-84 and will be assigned to Station 170
- SPFR received an appreciation comment on "Eatonville Heads Up" for a dumpster fire at a local apartment complex
- SPFR participated in the Eatonville Christmas Parade on December 5th. We staged in front of the new Administrative Offices and were pleased to have Mr. & Mrs. Santa Claus with the fire apparatus
