

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-7

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE,
WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE 2019 UPDATE TO THE
EATONVILLE SHORELINE MASTER PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Washington Shoreline Management Act, Chapter 90.58 RCW (“SMA”), recognizes that shorelines are among the most valuable and fragile resources of the state, and that state and local government must establish a coordinated planning program to address the types and effects of development occurring along shorelines of state-wide significance; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Eatonville (“Town”) is required to update its Shoreline Master Program (“SMP”) pursuant to the SMA and Chapter 173-26 WAC; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2019, the Town’s State Environmental Policy Act responsible official completed his review and issued a determination of nonsignificance; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Ecology issued their comments regarding the SMP Update on August 6, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Town’s planning commission considered the SMP Update and Ecology’s comments at a public meeting and, following a duly noticed public hearing, recommended approval of the SMP Update, a copy of which is attached as Attachment A; and

WHEREAS, the Eatonville Town Council would like to adopt the SMP Update, which incorporates comments from the State Department of Ecology; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Eatonville Town Council hereby adopts the 2019 update to the Town’s Shoreline Master Program, a copy of which is attached as Attachment A and incorporated by this reference.


Section 2. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be preempted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or preemption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its

application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after publication of a summary, consisting of the title, pursuant to RCW 35.27.300.




