Recent Events

The Mary Bridge Hospital Courage Ride was centered around Mill Town Park on August 26th. Eatonville Officers provided escorts and traffic control posts for the event.

Training

Our 2017 mandatory training classes (to include defensive tactics, first aid, active shooter, emergency vehicle operations, and legal updates) are now completed. Summer and winter Firearms have also been scheduled and/or attended.

Officer Gill graduated from the state academy on May 24th and has completed the FTO program. He has completed the advanced roadside impaired driving enforcement class.

All EPD officers will be attending at least 8 hours of Crisis Intervention Training to comply with state requirements/mandates. I would like to see more of us attend the 40 hour class that Officer Anderson just completed. The training will be scheduled as staffing allows.

Management Activities

- August was the first month since the inception of the Pierce County Sheriff's Department after hours
 response contract where the town of Eatonville will not be billed for a single county response. We had
 been averaging 7 calls per month with some summer months having as many as 16 responses. Our
 recent hire plays a big role in the reduction of PCSD responses. With a staff of five, the need for this
 contract will continue. We just happened to be lucky in August that no calls for service came in while
 we were not staffed with EPD Officers.
- Our 2017 Ford interceptor has been delivered to Systems for Public Safety in Lakewood and should be in service before the end of the month. Another new car will be ordered as soon as the State bid is set.
- Officer McGuire has been working hard on our transition to the Lexipol Policy manual. This policy manual will be updated automatically as case law changes. The Lexipol Company will keep the department abreast of these requirements and recommend changes when necessary. This process will ensure that our department is meeting local, state, and federal standards. This initial manual may take several months to complete. I will update the mayor and council when the policy manual is completed.
- Review of Town Codes and enforcement procedures is ongoing.
- Officer Wade is assisting the School District with their campus security assessments. The high School
 assessment has been submitted to the district.
- Gaille is updating and finalizing our Emergency Management Plan. The recent hurricane and flood in
 Houston as well as our own state's wildland fires have brought Emergency Management issues to the
 forefront. Please visit www.piercecountywa.org/emergency for tips on emergency resources and an
 explanation evacuation levels. There is also some good information on PCALERT. This
 communication service is free and will call, text, and email you in the event of an emergency in your
 area. Much is this information will also be made available on the town's Facebook page.

Significant Cases/Issues

I just responded to the report of a dog left locked in a car at the post office. The temperature is in the 90's. I walked over there with a halligan tool to break the window. Lucky for us all, the owner had removed the dog prior to my arrival. Please understand that if we have no other recourse than to break a window, we will do so without searching for an owner first. Please leave your dogs at home on these hot days.

We have identified two burglar/thieves that have committed crimes in Eatonville in recent months. There are now warrants for both suspect's arrest.

Suspicious people and activity – if someone looks suspicious or out of place, please call (253) 798-4721. An Officer will be dispatched 24 hours a day 7 days a week.

Homeless/Panhandling - We have had an influx of homeless people that are aggressively panhandling or harassing citizens. We have been trying to connect those people with available services in other cities. Many times these people have issues with drug addictions or mental conditions that necessitate a medical facility that Eatonville simply does not have.
