**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE,
WASHINGTON, AWARDED A BID FOR CONSTRUCTION
SR/161 WASHINGTON AVENUE NORTH CORRIDOR
STREETSCAPE PROJECT TO NORTHEAST ELECTRIC, LLC**

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2011 the Town of Eatonville entered into a Local Agency Agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for the SR 161 Washington Avenue North Corridor Streetscape and Design Project. KPG, P.S. is the contractor performing the construction management services for this project; and

WHEREAS, the primary goal of the project is to provide and upgrade the pedestrian features and amenities from the intersection of Lynch Creek Road / SR 161 to Center Street/SR 161, as well as to provide architectural and landscape amenities throughout the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the project is funded by State and Federal grants with the fiscal impact to the Town of Eatonville of \$87,440; and

WHEREAS, the Town solicited bids for the work according to Washington State bid laws and the lowest responsible bid was received from Northeast Electric, LLC. in the amount of \$841,240.00; now, therefore;

**THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE,
WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

THAT: A contract with Northeast Electric, LLC in the amount of \$841,240.00 for construction of this phase of the SR 161/WA Avenue North Corridor Streetscape project is approved; and

FURTHER THAT: The Mayor of the Town of Eatonville is authorized to sign a contract with Northeast Electric, LLC. in a form approved by the Town Attorney.

Dear Ms. Gribi,

As requested, KPG has completed the verification for Northeast Electric, LLC for the SR161/Washington Ave N. Corridor Streetscape Project.

We have checked the status of Northeast Electric, LLC on the Washington State Labor and Industries web page to confirm they are currently insured, bonded, and licensed. Additionally, no strikes or debarment records arose federally or statewide regarding Northeast Electric, LLC. There were not any subcontractors listed on their bid form to confirm.

We phoned the four references listed in Northeast Electric's bid and were able to speak with, and receive feedback from, all of them. All references involved projects for WSDOT and we received positive responses from all of them. Northeast Electric is on WSDOT's Prequalified Contractors list and has worked often with WSDOT and they spoke very highly of Northeast's work.

We also spoke to Mark Burlingame, Public Works Director, with the City of Steilacoom as Northeast Electric worked on a project for them in Steilacoom. Mark said he was a little skeptical of Northeast Electric at first since he had not worked with them before and they would be coming from Woodland, a distance away from the project in Steilacoom. Mark said they did a beautiful job and he would gladly work with them again.

WSDOT Local Programs has approved Northeast Electric and it is KPG's recommendation that the SR161/Washington Ave N. Corridor Streetscape project be awarded to Northeast Electric, LLC.

We have enclosed the contractor verification package and reference checks for your review.
