Recent Events

- The Rod Knockers car show was held on June 24th. The heat may have kept some car owners from attending. I was told that they were about 75 cars below their average showing. I enjoyed having some input on the "Police Chief's Award". We did have an arrest during the car show when a motorist exposed himself to two young girls. We are working closely with our prosecutor to ensure that the arrestee is prosecuted, as a recent arrest for the same person's behavior was not charged by another court.
- During the July 3 fireworks show we had 5-7 lost kids that were reunited with their parents thanks to quick work by the C.E.R.T. volunteers that assisted us with both events. Officers Wade and Anderson worked bicycle patrol on our two new police mountain bikes. Seattle Police Officer Bruce Case (ex EPD 6), kept us in mind when SPD changed to a new model of bicycle that was geared for their hilly terrain and presented two surplus police bicycles to Eatonville Police last week. These bicycles have served Seattle well and have been kept in top condition. I estimated the crowd at the fireworks show to be in the 6-8000 range. The air crew from Airlift Northwest and their helicopter were a big hit with kids and adults alike. I would also like to thank Chief Galey and the volunteer fire fighters from South Pierce Fire and Rescue that staffed an engine for the entire event. The Pierce County Sheriff's armored, "Bearcat", was a hit with the kids as well.
- The 4th of July Parade was very well attended. I would like to thank those residents that were not able to get home for about 45 minutes during the parade. The people that I spoke with were very cordial and understood that our roadblocks were a necessary safety precaution.

Training

Our 2017 mandatory training classes (to include defensive tactics, first aid, active shooter, emergency vehicle operations, and legal updates) are now completed. Summer and winter Firearms have also been scheduled and/or attended.

Officer Gill graduated from the state academy on May 24th and is in the FTO program with Officer McGuire. He will be attending classes on Drug Impaired Drivers, Taser/C. E. W, and Defensive Tactics/Vascular Neck Restraints as soon as they are posted with P.C.S.D.

All EPD officers will be attending at least 8 hours of Crisis Intervention Training to comply with state requirements/mandates. I would like to see more of us attend the 40-hour CIT class that Officer Anderson just completed. The training will be scheduled as staffing allows.

Management Activities

- Officer McGuire has been working hard on our transition to the Lexipol Policy manual. This policy
 manual will be updated automatically as case law changes. The Lexipol Company will keep the
 department abreast of these requirements and recommend changes when necessary. This process
 will ensure that our department is meeting local, state, and federal standards. This initial manual may
 take several months to complete. I will update the mayor and council when the policy manual is
 completed.
- Review of Town Codes and enforcement procedures is ongoing.
- Officer Wade is assisting the School District with their campus security assessments.
- Gaille is updating our Emergency Management Plan. She and I attended a recent regional meeting
 with the Department of Emergency Management regarding hazard mitigation.
- We are also looking forward to National Night Out on August 1. The Eatonville Police Department will be hosting an informational barbecue at the visitor's center on July 11 at 6:30. If you are interested in setting up/hosting a neighborhood gathering, or if you are a business interested hosting an event for the National Night Out on August 1st, please plan on attending the informational meeting. If you can't attend the planning meeting and you want more information on this event, contact the Eatonville Police Department.

Significant Cases/Issues

Vehicle prowls/thefts - Please remember to secure your vehicles and not to leave valuables in plain sight.

Suspicious people and activity – if someone looks suspicious or out of place, please call the non-emergency dispatch number at (253) 798-4721. **An Officer will be dispatched 24 hours a day 7 days a week.**

Homeless/Panhandling - We have had an influx of homeless people that are aggressively panhandling or harassing citizens. We have been trying to connect those people with available services in other cities and areas. Many times, these people have issues with drug addictions or mental conditions that necessitate a medical/mental facility that Eatonville simply does not have.
