**Summary:** The Town voted to increase electric rates in July 2015. Before that time there had not been an increase in electricity rates since 2004. During 2015, the public utilities committee spent time reviewing and evaluating fiscal and rate information relating to the Town's electric utility, and the Mayor held two duly noticed informational meetings to inform the public about the proposed rate increase and to answer questions. The review by the Public Utilities Committee and the public informational meetings both discussed and reviewed increases that were implemented for 2015 and 2016 and recommended an additional review of the Electric Fund for ongoing stability in the Spring of 2017. Based on its review, the committee recommends adoption of the rate increases set forth in the Resolution. The proposed increases are consistent with the Town's 10-year Electric Utility Strategic Plan prepared by EES Consulting. The base rate covers the fixed operating costs of operating the utility. The energy charge covers the cost of wholesale power, transmission fees, capital expenses, debt service, and taxes. The demand charge is limited to those high energy users who have a demand meter.

**Recommendation:** Staff recommends adoption of Resolution No. 2017-S setting the rates for electric service, energy, and demand and repealing Resolution No. 2016-R.

**Motion for consideration:** I move to adopt Resolution No. 2017-S setting the rates for electric service, energy, and demand and repealing Resolution No. 2016-R.

**Fiscal Impact:** If adopted, the rate increase will be effective August 1, 2017.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017-S**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON,  
SETTING THE RATES FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE, ENERGY, AND  
DEMAND AND REPEALING RESOLUTION No. 2016-R**

**WHEREAS**, EES Consulting has developed a 10 year Capital Improvement Plan and a Long-Term Strategic Electric System Plan for the Town of Eatonville; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to meet the operating and maintenance costs of the Electric Department, maintain our infrastructure, fund the recommended capital projects and asset replacement, a rate increase is required; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Utility Committee has reviewed the revenue and fund balances of the Electric Fund and the Committee recommends the adoption of a 5% rate increase effective August 1, 2017 and a 5% rate increase effective August 1, 2018 ; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed increases are consistent with the Town's 10-year Electric Utility Strategic Plan prepared by EES Consulting; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has considered the recommendation from the Public Utility Committee and the Finance Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council finds that, despite the proposed rate increase, the Town's electricity rates remain competitive with the rates charged by other electric utilities in the area and the additional revenue is needed to help pay operations and maintenance costs for the existing system and to enable the utility to add to its fund balance for long term capital facility improvements; now, therefore;

**THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, WASHINGTON,  
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**THAT:** Resolution No. 2016-R is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**AND FURTHER THAT:** Effective August 1, 2017, the monthly charges for electric service, energy, and demand in the Town of Eatonville shall be as follows:

1. Residential. The monthly rate shall be the sum of the following base and energy charges:
  - a. Base = \$21.50
  - b. Energy:
    - i. 0 - 1,000 kWh = \$0.06367 per kWh
    - ii. 1,001 - 2,000 kWh = \$0.06458 per kWh
    - iii. Over 2,000 kWh = \$ 0.06580 per kWh

2. Commercial. The monthly rate shall be the sum of the following base and energy charges:
  - a. Base = \$28.11
  - b. Energy:
    - i. 0 - 5,000 kWh = \$0.06143 per kWh
    - ii. 5,001 - 7,500 kWh = \$0.06367 per kWh
    - iii. Over 7,500 kWh = \$0.06458 per kWh
  
3. Governmental. The monthly rate shall be the sum of the following base and energy charges:
  - a. Base = \$62.29
  - b. Energy:
    - i. 0 - 10,000 kWh = \$0.06023 per kWh
    - ii. 10,001 – 20,000 kWh = \$0.06225 per kWh
    - iii. Over 20,000 kWh = \$0.06389 per kWh
  
4. Demand. Charges for electric energy demand shall be calculated based on the customer's average usage during the 15-minute period of the customer's highest usage during the month. Demand charges shall be as follows:
  - a. There shall be no charge for demand less than 50 kilowatts; and
  - b. For demand in excess of 50 kilowatts, the charge shall be \$5.21 per kWh.

**AND FURTHER THAT:** Effective August 1, 2018, there shall be a 5% increase in the monthly charges for electric service, energy, and demand in the Town of Eatonville.

**AND FURTHER THAT:** This Resolution shall be effective August 1, 2017.
