MINUTES OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING**

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Schaub called the meeting of the Eatonville Town Council to order at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL

- a. **Police Report-** Police Chief Witt announced that Gaille Finley recently attended Access Certified Training and that Officer Wade has recently attended SEPTC training. Officer Wade will be performing a security site assessment for the Eatonville School District. Chief Witt also announced that the LEMAP study will begin tomorrow.
- b. **Airport Committee-** Councilmember Thomas reported that the Airport Committee met on September 19, 2016 and discussed additions to the Comprehensive Plan.
- c. **Mayor Report-** Mayor Schaub announced that the Town is doing an inventory of crosswalks and stop bars that are faded, with a focus on the ones near the schools and will be creating a schedule to have them resurfaced every couple years using the torch down material. He also reported that a citizen came into Town Hall to complain about the \$20.00 TBD fee and that the only other source of revenue for the Streets Fund comes from the fuel tax or REET.
